

K–8 Athletics

The Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Therapeutic League (WPITL) is a league designed for students enrolled in private school programs with therapeutic support components. The league consists of 12 Private and Approved Private Schools. The focus of the Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic Therapeutic League is not about winning and losing, but rather to promote participation and to teach our student athletes fair play, teamwork, and sportsmanship. All events take place during the school day so after school hours transportation is not required. The current sports are Flag Football, Basketball, Kickball, and Cheerleading. There is a Middle school and High school division for each sport.

Mission

The K-8 Sports Program's mission is to provide participation in flag football, basketball, kickball and cheerleading in order for students to learn teamwork, fair play, and personal enjoyment. We want our students to attend every event in order to experience community involvement and interacting with students their own age to improve social skills.

Eligibility & Attendance Policy

Students at Wesley K-8 must follow the 3 Bee's (Be Respectful, Be Responsible and Be Safe) in order to participate in weekly events. The students must earn choice Level 3 time (51–60 points) Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, as well as appropriate behavior the day of the sporting event, to play in the game on Thursday. An excused absence must be turned in the next day in order to count.

Grades

Students in 6th, 7th and 8th grade are eligible to participate.

Sports Class

A sportsmanship class is mandatory for any students who want to participate in the athletic program. Topics include sportsmanship, teamwork, positive athletes, concussion and sports rules. There will be one class per sport/season.
