

Symptom Screening Tool

Pre-screening **MUST** take place prior to each school day. Please ensure you or a member of your household completes this prior to your student attending school. Prescreening questions include the following:

- Temperature

- Is the student taking any medication to treat or reduce a fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e. Advil, Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)?

- **Is the student or a member of your immediate household experiencing any of the following symptoms today or within the last 14 days:**

Group A 1 or more symptoms	Group B 2 or more symptoms
Fever (100.4 or higher) Cough Shortness of breath Difficulty breathing Loss of smell Loss of taste	Fever (above 98.6 and under 100.4) Chills Rigors (shivers) Myalgia (muscle pain) Headache Sore throat Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea Fatigue Congestion or runny nose

Please keep your student home if you or a member of your immediate household:

- Have one or more symptoms in Group A **OR**
- Have two or more symptoms in Group B **OR**
- Are taking fever reducing medication.

In the event that you, the student or an immediate household member has received a positive COVID-19 test, is awaiting confirmation of results from a COVID test, or if your child is showing any of the above symptoms, please contact your child's school at (412) 833-6444 for Wesley K-8 or (412) 885-7017 for Wesley High School.
