Wesley Schools Partial Hospital Services

Program Goals: Our goal is to integrate education and the mental health services of a partial hospital program to students who are enrolled in ESY and meet medical necessity criteria for partial hospital services.

Program Description:

- Mental health services include: group, individual and milieu therapy
- Family therapy to reduce child-related conflict and stress in the home
- Psychiatric consultation and medication management

Who is eligible?

K-8 school-aged children who qualify for partial hospital and ESY services.

WESLEY KINDERGARTEN & K-8 SCHOOL ESY

Program Goal:

Our goal is to provide additional learning opportunities for students needing social and emotional support. The students will work on individual and group goals through a structured learning environment and the use of Creative Arts and Adventure-Based Counseling. Prevocational work study opportunities will be provided for those students who meet requirements.

Program Description:

- Therapeutic activities focusing on life, leisure and social skills through creative lessons
- Programs focusing on cooperation, trust, communication, and self-esteem
- Therapeutic support to promote family cohesiveness
- Field trips scheduled for social skills training and community-based instruction
- Community service activities
- Direct instruction and practice with social and executive functioning skills, perspective taking and emotional regulation

Who is eligible?

The K-8 ESY program is designed for students in K-8th grade. The program is for students that qualify for ESY services and would benefit from an educational therapeutic program in the summer. *This year's ESY is being held at Wesley High School.*

WESLEY HIGH SCHOOL ESY

Program Goal:

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Our goal is to provide additional social, emotional and academic skill building opportunities through structured credit recovery or academic enrichment and work study programming.

Program Description:

- Academic instruction and enrichment provided in a blending learning environment
- Skill building focused on life, leisure, and social skills through creative activities in a therapeutic milieu and practiced during career-readiness class or community outings
- Activities focused on cooperation, trust and self-esteem
- Direct instruction and practice with social and executive functioning skills, perspective taking and emotional regulation
- On-site work experience for those who qualify (Work Permit is required)

Who is eligible?

The High School ESY program is designed for students in $9^{\text{th}} - 12^{\text{th}}$ grades. The program is for students who qualify for ESY services and would benefit from an educational therapeutic program in the summer.
