Transportation?

What should they expect at prom?

- When guests arrive, they will be able to choose their table and seat.
- There will be light hors d'oeuvres to snack on before dinner is served
- An announcement will be made for dinner all guests are expected to be seated at this time and through dessert
- After dinner, dancing will begin

What about pictures?

- We will have staff available to take "formal pictures" that will be available for purchase at another point in time at school.
- You may take pictures, but please ask if other people would like to be a part of them.

Do I have to stay in the room where Prom is happening?

- It is your child's responsibility to be in the area of our event for the duration of prom. There is a balcony and seating areas in the hallway if they would like to take a break from the room.
- Leaving the event without permission, will result in consequences including, but not limited to:
 - Suspension from school or upcoming student events (senior breakfast, student picnic etc...)
 - Prohibited from attending the 2025 Graduation ceremony (this includes seniors)
- Once a student leaves prom, they cannot return. Wesley chaperones will no longer be able to monitor their safety
- The renting of hotel rooms is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
